Creation of an information document for individuals seeking medical school outside Canada.

Whereas no organization in Canada informs applicants to medical school about the issues or pitfalls that may await them in returning to Canada for residency training after obtaining medical education at schools not accredited by Liaison Committee on Medical Education/Committee on Accreditation of Canadian Medical Schools (LCME/CACMS);

**Whereas** the CFMS can educate applicants to medical schools on the challenges faced by International Medical Graduates (IMGs) of Canadian origin;

**BIRT** the CFMS create an information document highlighting potential issues and challenges that Canadian citizens or permanent residents may encounter in seeking residency training in Canada after receiving medical education at schools not accredited by LCME/CACMS.
